

Surveys | Viewing results online

- Log into your FinxS account and select **“Surveys”** under the **“Database”** tab.
- **Click on the** name of the Survey you would like to view.
- **Click “Generate report”** towards the top of the screen. FinxS will advise it will consume 100 points if there are fewer than 101 people responding. (There are no additional costs to view results once the first 100 points have been deducted).

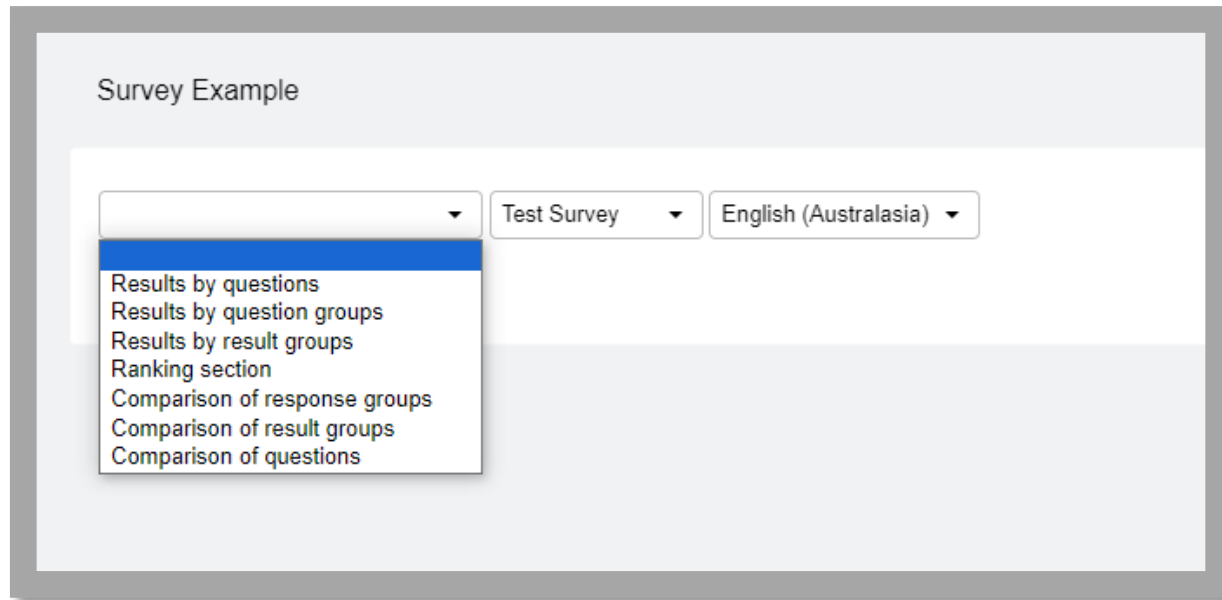

- The next screen that appears will provide you with seven different ways of viewing the results.
- To view the seven options, locate the empty box beneath the survey name on the top left of the screen (see screenshot below). Click on the ▼ inside the empty box and select from the given options:



1. Ranking Section

Survey results are displayed using numbers and traffic light colours.

- **Green** indicates a high score.
The **top 25%** of the scale.
- **Yellow** indicates there is some room for improvement.
Between 25% - 75% of the scale.
- **Red** indicates a definite area to improve.
The **bottom 25%** of the scale.

The first table displays an overview of each question group with scores ranked highest to lowest. By clicking on the little arrows next to the response groups, you can manipulate the order of the data and the questions.

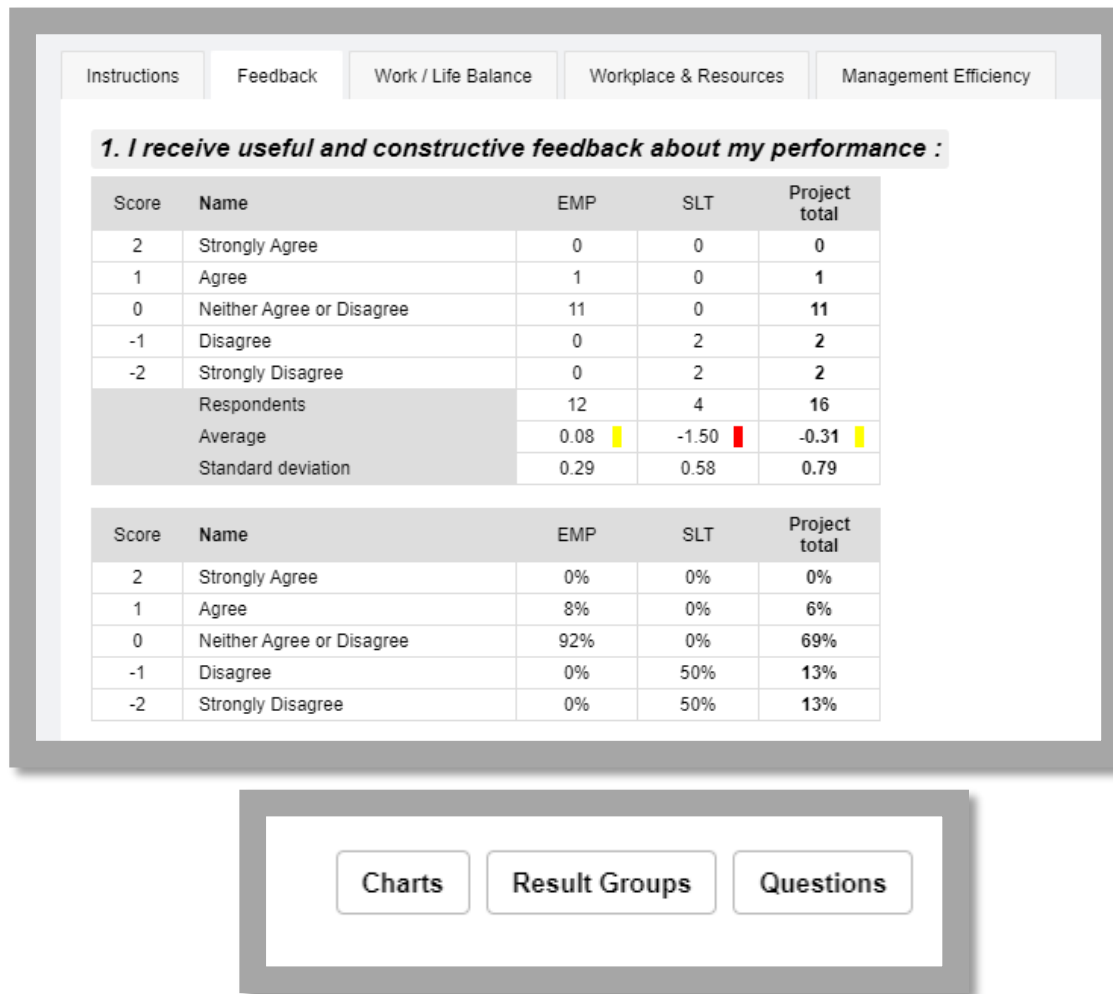

- It is possible to **edit the response groups** viewed on screen.

 - Click “Questions”, top right, and deselect or select the questions you want to remove or show.
- Nb: You can also view the Total Column results of **other Surveys** in your account.
 - However, this will only be possible if you have used the same “Child Questionnaire”.
 - Click “Projects” (top right) to select and deselect projects to view.

2. Results by Question

The “Results by Questions” view shows each question within its question group. Simply click on the named question group tab to view the questions within that question group.



- There are **nine charts** that can be used to display "Results by Question" – Basic Bar, Floating Bar, Stacked Bar, Basic Column, Floating Column, Stacked Column, Pie Chart, Spider Web and Line Chart.
 - Click "Charts" towards the top right and make your selection. The charts will appear below the tables.
- It is possible to **edit the response groups** viewed on screen.
 - Click "Result Groups" towards the top right and select or deselect the response groups you wish to view.

- It is also possible to **edit** the viewing of **individual questions**.
 - Click “Questions”, top right, and deselect or select the questions you want to remove or show.
- Additionally, you can view the **Total Column** results of other **Survey Projects** in your account.
 - However, this will only be possible if you have used the same “Child Questionnaire”.
 - Click “Projects”, top right, and select and deselect the projects you wish to view.
- **Open Ended Questions** can be included or removed by selecting “Show open ended” in the top left of the screen.
 - These questions will appear at the very bottom of the question group.

3. Results by Question Groups

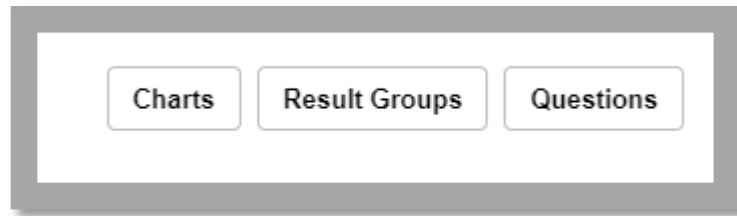
“Results by Question Groups” gives an overall summary of all the question groups followed by all the questions within each group. This view is the simplest way to view the results of a Survey.



 - Open Ended Questions can be included or removed by selecting "Show open ended", top left.


- These questions will appear at the very bottom of the question group.
